Clay County Sheriff's Office Modernization Initiative (FY27 DOJ COPS Grant Proposal)

Dear Trent:

I hope you are doing well. As always, thank you for the work you do for Northeast Mississippi and for the people of our district. I'm reaching out both officially and personally, as your friend and as the Sheriff of Clay County, to ask for your support of our FY2027 DOJ COPS Grant proposal, the *Clay County Sheriff's Office Modernization Initiative*.

As you know, Clay County is a rural county with large service areas and limited local resources. Our deputies respond to a wide range of calls across many miles of county roads, and we're often called on to assist with everything from traffic and crashes to manhunts, severe weather events, and jail-related emergencies. We have dedicated personnel, but we need modern tools to keep our deputies safe and to protect the public effectively.

This proposal requests funding for the following items, each of which would directly improve public safety in Clay County:

- **Mobile Command and Control Trailer** – This would give us a reliable, on-scene base of operations during major incidents such as missing person searches, severe weather events, large accidents, and multi-agency operations. It improves coordination, communications, and command presence when time and organization matter most. It is important to note that this mobile command center can be used on a multi-jurisdiction basis allowing us to assist other agencies and respond to emergencies far outside our area of operations. With our proximity to Columbus Air Force Base, we would be able to set up outside command and control in the event of a terrorist attack or other catastrophic events. In fact, our plan is to be able to deploy as a quick response force (QRF) in times of need within a one hundred square mile radius.
- **Truck to Tow the Mobile Command Center** – The trailer is only useful if we can deploy it quickly and safely. A dedicated tow vehicle ensures we can move the command center where it's needed without delay and without pulling another critical patrol vehicle out of service.
- **X-Ray Machine for the Clay County Jail** – This is a major safety need for our detention staff and inmates. It helps us detect contraband and weapons, reduces risk during intake and searches, and improves overall jail security while minimizing unnecessary physical contact.

- **Ten (10) License Plate Recognition (LPR) Cameras** – LPR cameras help us identify stolen vehicles, locate suspects, and detect vehicles tied to crimes moving through or operating in the county. They also support investigations and can serve as a strong deterrent in problem areas.
- **22 Kevlar Vests for Deputies** – Simply put, this is about officer safety. Deputies cannot protect the public if they are not protected themselves. Updated protective vests help ensure our deputies have the basic safety equipment needed for daily patrol and high-risk calls.
- **Prisoner Transport Van** – Safe transport is a constant need in our work moving inmates for court, medical care, and transfers. A dedicated transport van improves safety for deputies and the public, reduces liability, and ensures we can complete transports without taking multiple patrol units off the road.
- **30 Handheld Radios** – Our current radios are unreliable and need updating. Handheld radios are an absolute necessity and are desperately needed.
- **25 In-Car Radios** – As with our handheld radios, our in-car radios are rapidly aging and need to be replaced. Trustworthy communication is vital to our everyday operations, and these new radios are crucial to our service to the community.

These items are not “nice to have” for us, they are necessary improvements that will help us respond faster, operate safer, and serve Clay County more effectively. Federal support through this program would make a real difference for our residents, especially in the rural areas where resources are stretched the most.



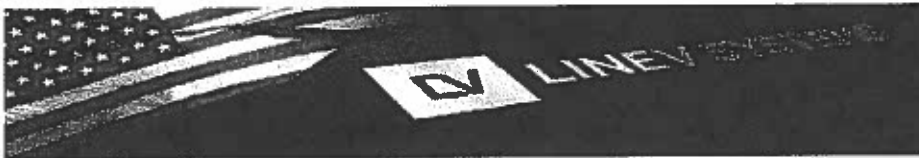

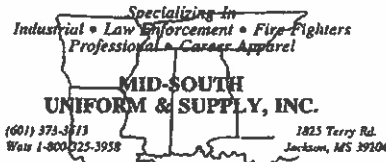
