On behalf of the City of Oxford, please accept this correspondence as an official Letter of Support for a Community project funding allocation as part of the FY2025 Energy & Water (E&W) appropriations process. Oxford continues its comprehensive approach for the development of capabilities for water, wastewater service, non-point and stormwater management within the City and contiguous areas.
